Members are naturally very annoyed that we have such large quotas for December for many stocks, including Prawns, Haddock, Monk etc, when the monthly amounts were so reduced in earlier months. The quotas given out each month is based on the information we were given by DAFF at each monthly meeting. IFPO has expressed at the Whitefish Quota Management our serious concern that this has been very frustrating and expensive for fishermen, and stressed the vital importance of getting these figures right from now on.
